From the Parish Priest

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Happy New Year!

I recently came across, again, the Surrender Prayer by Fr Dolindo Ruotolo. You may have seen it. I thought it would be a great way of us starting the year together as a parish. In the Gospel this weekend we see Jesus at the beginning of his ministry calling the first disciples to follow him. He calls us too, as his disciples, to follow him into this new year.

In the Surrender Prayer we pray,

O Jesus, I surrender myself to you, take care of everything.

In this devotion Fr Dolindo heard Jesus say to him,

"Why do you confuse yourself by worrying?

Leave the care of your affairs to me and everything will be peaceful. I say to you in truth that every act of true, blind, complete surrender to Me produces the effect that you desire and resolves all difficult situations."

and

"How many things I do when the soul, in so much spiritual and material need turns to Me, looks at Me and says to me, "You take care of it," then closes its eyes and rests.....and when I must lead you on a path different from the one you see, I will prepare you. I will carry you in my arms; I will let you find yourself, like children who have fallen asleep in their mother's arms, on the other bank of the river."

We have much to do this year, things to plan alongside the ordinary life of the parish. The same will be in your homes. This surrender does not mean we do not have to act but rather that we have this attitude of surrender and trust at the bottom of our hearts.

O Jesus, I surrender myself to you, take care of everything.

I will be away this weekend celebrating my great nephew Oliver's baptism in Auckland.

WORD OF GOD SUNDAY (THIRD SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME)

On the third Sunday in Ordinary Time, Word of God Sunday, we join Catholics throughout the world in re-committing and deepening our engagement with Sacred Scripture. The theme this year is from John 8:31 "Remain in My Word." Salvation, faith, unity and mercy all depend on knowing Christ and Sacred Scripture.

WHAT CAN WE DO?

Below are some suggestions for this Sunday with reference to Pope Francis' Apostolic Letter Motu Proprio Aperuit illis (2019).

Focus attention in the liturgy. "It is important that in the Eucharistic celebration the sacred text be enthroned, in order to focus the attention of the assembly on the normative value of God's word."

Pray for Proclaimers of the Word. Take the opportunity on Word of God Sunday to pray for those who are entrusted with reading the Scriptures at Mass.

Commit time to reflect on the Word. Read the scriptures of the following Sunday as a companion for daily reflection and ministry. Share with others your own reflections for the following Sunday's readings.

Lectio Divina. Listen to the scripture readings each day. Lectio Divina is a method of prayer for listening to scripture with our hearts.
