The Mercy of Christ our Redeemer

Dear Parishioners

SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER

At the Vigil of Easter last weekend we heard the words of the Exultet: "O happy Fault...which gained for us so great a Redeemer."

In Pope St John Paul II's Encyclical Letter Redemptor Hominis, he writes: "In many and various ways God spoke of old to our fathers by the prophets; but in these last days he has spoken to us by a Son.... (Hebrews 1:1-2), by the Son, his Word, who became man and was born of the Virgin Mary. This act of redemption marked the high point of the history of humanity within God's loving plan."

Following the announcement of the bishop last weekend our parish now sets off on our journey under the patronage of **Christ the Redeemer.** What a grace that will be for us! During the year we will be led in the liturgy and in our lives to explore the riches of Christ as our Redeemer.

This Sunday, Divine Mercy Sunday, the emphasis is on the mercy of our Redeemer.

In the Gospel of John, the Risen Jesus institutes the Sacrament of Reconciliation. He breathes the Holy Spirit on the Apostles and says for those whose sins you forgive; they are forgiven; for those whose sins you retain, they are retained.

Sister Faustina was a young, uneducated nun in a convent of the Congregation of Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy in Poland during the 1930s. She came from a poor family that struggled during the years of World War I. She had only three years of simple education, so hers were the humblest tasks in the convent, usually in the kitchen or garden. However, she received extraordinary revelations — or messages — from our Lord Jesus. Jesus asked Sr. Faustina to record these experiences, which she compiled into notebooks. These notebooks are known today as the Diary of Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska, and the words contained within are God's loving message of Divine Mercy.

"Write, speak of My mercy. Tell souls where they are to look for solace; that is, in the Tribunal of Mercy [the Sacrament of Reconciliation]. There the greatest miracles take place [and] are incessantly repeated. To avail oneself of this miracle, it is not necessary to go on a great pilgrimage or to carry out some external ceremony; it suffices to come with faith to the feet of My representative and to reveal to him one's misery, and the miracle of Divine Mercy will be fully demonstrated. Were a soul like a decaying corpse so that from a human standpoint, there would be no [hope of] restoration and everything would already be lost, it is not so with God. The miracle of Divine Mercy restores that soul in full. Oh, how miserable are those who do not take advantage of the miracle of God's mercy! You will call out in vain, but it will be too late. "

(Divine Mercy in My Soul, Diary of Saint Maria Faustina, Book V, 1448)

We are going to have two combined Masses at St Andrew's College Chapel for Pentecost Weekend.


