The Discernment Continues...

Kia ora e te whānau,

We have concluded the process of discerning our Patronal Name, and Msgr. Rick has sent a letter to Bishop Michael for review. This letter contains a detailed explanation of the journey and process leading to our results.

The Bishop, after discerning will get back to us, issuing a decree on our new Patronal Name. (Please note that our process is advisory, and ultimately the Bishop has the final decision.)

Last Sunday, we invited all those who were present at our Sunday Masses to vote before the final blessing. We also received votes via email, and we invited our parish schools and those who are sick and housebound to submit their votes early.

Overall, we received 1,205 votes, and the results are as follows:

- Christ the Redeemer: 574
- St. Teresa of Calcutta: 388
- St. John the Evangelist: 243

How did we get here?

From Sunday, December 10th, to Sunday, January 28th, we invited the entire parish to start praying to the Holy Spirit, helping us think of worthy patrons for submission.

Then, from Monday, January 29th, to Sunday, February 4th, we invited everyone to submit a suggested patron for consideration and discernment.

We received 134 submissions during this period.

From the 134 submissions, we had 67 unique suggestions for patrons. We narrowed the suggestions down to the top 9, which were then sent to the Priests, Leadership Team, and Parish Staff.

We were going to present the top three suggestions on February 10th and 11th, but we extended the period of discernment.

During this extended period, we had to exclude St. Joseph (as this was a prior parish patron), and with West Parish now falling under Holy Family, we also had to exclude Holy Family. This narrowed the suggestions down to the top seven.

We then sent the revised top seven suggested patrons to the parish staff, priests, and leadership team for them to rate the top three patrons in order of preference, using a point system. This allowed us to establish a rating system that would bring us a top three

The top three were **Christ the Redeemer, St. John the Baptist, and St. John the Evangelist.** However, after receiving direction from Bishop Michael, we had to remove St. John the Baptist as an option. Consequently, the Leadership Team agreed to select the next top patron - **St. Teresa of Calcutta.**

After a period of discernment, we invited the parish to vote over the weekend of March 9th and 10th.

On behalf of Msgr. Rick, the priests, the leadership team, and parish staff, we thank you for your prayerful discernment throughout this process. May the Holy Spirit now guide Bishop Michael as he makes his decision on who will be our patron.


