From the Parish Priest

Dear Parishioners,

Have you noticed that love carries its own judgment? When we are loved, a standard, a measure of human behaviour, is raised before us. Being loved sets a path of love, a way of living, in front of us. When we receive forgiveness or mercy, our hearts can be transformed, opening us to being loving ourselves.

In this famous passage from the Gospel this Sunday, Jesus says, **"For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not be lost but may have eternal life."** There is a call to faith from us if the abundant and merciful love of God, revealed in the face of his suffering Son, is to work in and through us. We must believe in Jesus—that he is from the Father and that he loves us; that he is the way, the truth, and the life, and that we are called to follow him.

During this Lenten season, we must ask ourselves: In what ways do we prefer the darkness? In what ways do we struggle with darkness in our lives? Perhaps our first task is to be open to God's love poured out on us, to be still before God, allowing His presence to challenge our hopes, desires, and how we live.

A big thank you to those who were able to attend the parish gathering last Sunday afternoon. It was heartening to see many of you there. We appreciated the guestions, comments, and concerns expressed during the presentations.

The minutes of this meeting and the PowerPoint presentations will be made available on the parish website from Wednesday, 13 March.

We will take time to review the feedback and provide further information. The Building Committee will meet this Sunday with the architect to further develop a timeline for the Visionary Concept phase of the new Church. We will keep the Parish updated in the Builletin as we progress.
