The Divine Healer

It's fair to say that we've had one heck of a year!

You only have to read, watch, stream the news to see the ongoing effect of the pandemic. A few weeks ago images of individuals struggling to be admitted into hospitals seemed to flood our screens, alongside videos of families in grief over the loss of loved ones who were not able to get the medical care they needed due to lack of medical supplies and an overwhelmed health system.

In the midst of this pandemic, we might turn and take comfort in the two miracles of healing and life that is presented to us this Sunday. We have is what is often called a "Markan sandwich" where one story is encased (or sandwiched) between the beginning and end of another.

Here, we have an unusual combination of **two** miracle stories, **one contained within the other** – a healing, and a restoration of life. The story of the woman with the flow of blood interrupts, and is sandwiched between, the two parts of the account of Jairus' plea for his dying daughter and its result.

There are a few parallels between both stories.

- The woman suffered from the haemorrhage for twelve years, while the little girl was only twelve years old.
- Both are called "daughter," and both are in need of physical healing.
- The girl's father (Jairus) is **encouraged to have faith**, while the older woman is **praised for her faith**.

The two stories this weekend illustrate Jesus' power over both chronic illness and death.

In these two miracles of healing, Jesus shows God's amazing generosity by giving the older woman and the young girl not just physical healing, but **life and salvation!**

As members of the Church, we are challenged to continue the work of **Jesus**, **the Divine Healer**. We are invited to do our share of Christ's healing mission by visiting the sick, by praying for their healing, and by boosting their morale through our loving presence, encouragement, support, and inspiration. Just a reminder: consoling and comforting are **spiritual works of mercy** while visiting the sick and the dying is a **corporal work of mercy**.

Just being present to those in need is healing! Coming to the aid of our neighbour in a time of need, both spiritual and physical, is a charitable action or "work of mercy" (Catholic Catechism #2447). When we serve those who are hurting, we serve Christ who identifies with them (CCC #544).

In a time where many people are becoming sick as a result of the pandemic our prayers for their healing and prayers for those who have died must increase – one of the ways we can do this is by utalising the prayer teams when they are available.

This **Wednesday (30 June)** we are holding a Votive Mass in time of pandemic. It's an opportunity for us to come together and pray for all who have been affected by the Coronavirus.




